

**PANCHAYAT YUVA KRIDA AUR KHEL ABHIYAN (PYKKA)**  
**MISSION DIRECTORATE PYKKA, ODISHA**

**THEME**

Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) a new Scheme introduced by Government of India in the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports during the Year 2007-08. The Physical education and Sports play a crucial role in all round development of Children, Youth and Adolescents who constitute seventy percent of the total population. With a View to encourage sports and games among the rural children, youth and Adolescents by providing them with access to basic sports infrastructures and Equipment at the Panchayat level, and opportunity to participate in sports competitions at the Block and District levels, leading to further opportunities for talented Sports persons emerging from this process to receive advanced training and exposure, and participate and excel in State, National and International tournaments. The draft Comprehensive National Sports Policy, 2008 prepared by the Ministry Of Youth Affairs and Sports proposes the implementation of a nationwide rural sports infrastructure Scheme christened the Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA). Accordingly Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports have notified the Scheme Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) in their Notification No.6-1/2007-SP-IV-dated 9<sup>th</sup> May 2008 for implementation in all states of the country.

**SCOPE OF THE SCHEME**

There is an immediate need to create a network of basic sports infrastructure throughout the state and ensure proper access to it to enable more people to participate in sports thereby broadening our base for scouting of talent. The programme will cover all village Panchayat (2, 50,000) and Block Panchayats (6373) / equivalent units of the country within the period of 10 years starting from 2008-09 and ending in 2017-18.

**Components of the Scheme and financial support to be provided**

1. One time Capital seed grant for development of Sports infrastructure Panchayat @ Rs.1, 00,000/ to each Gram & @ Rs.5, 00,000/- to each Block (75:25 Centre State ratio)
2. Annual Acquisition Grant for a period of five years for acquisition of sports equipments, Accessories, Sports fixtures, consumables and repairs/ maintenance @ Rs.10, 000/- to each Gram Panchayat and @ Rs.20, 000/- to each Block. (100% Central Assistance)
3. Annual operational grants for a period of five years to meet operational expenses of non competition activities including honorarium to Kridashree and maintenance of infrastructure @ Rs.12,000/- to each Gram Panchayat and @ Rs.24,000/- to each Block. (100% Central Assistance)

#### 4. Annual Competition Grant –

I- Rural Sports Competition – Maximum Amount of grant- Rs. 50,000/- @ Rs.10, 000/- per discipline for 5 disciplines for Block Level, Rs. 2, 00,000/- @ Rs. 20,000/- per discipline for 10 disciplines for District Level and Rs.10, 00,000/- @ Rs. 1, 00,000/- per disciplines for 10 disciplines for State Level Competition.

*II- Women Sports Competition- Women Sports Competition will be organized at Block , District and State Level for selection of players for their participation in National Level Sports Competition for which financial will be provided under the scheme as per details below*

- a. Block Level @ Rs.2,000/- per Block ( State Govt. Grant)
- b. District Level @ Rs. 10,000/- per discipline (Gol Grant)  
( for maximum 12 disciplines
- c. State Level Competition @ Rs. 50,000/0 per discipline  
For maximum 12 discipline ( Gol Grant)

5. Prize money in shape of cash prizes will be distributed among the medal winners at Block, District & State Level as per details given below

The district level Executive Committee will recommend phased coverage of Panchayats and Blocks within the overall Mission guidelines, approve Panchayats and Blocks Mission Plan and Annual Action Plan to be prepared in the prescribed format for creation of sports infrastructure and organization of Sports Competitions, finalize the District level Mission Plan to be prepared in the prescribed format, reallocate resources within the District within the overall Mission Guidelines, give overall guidance and directions , and monitor, review and evaluate the implementation of the Mission at the Panchayat Block and District Level and exercise such other powers as may be assigned to it by the State Level Executive Committee.

Implementation of the Scheme in the State will be looked after by the State Level Executive Committee as notified therein with following members.

The State level Executive Committee (SLEC) will approve District PYKKA Mission Plan and Annual Action Plans and finalize the State PYKKA Mission Plan and Annual Action Plans for creation of sports infrastructures and drawing up a annual calendar of competitions, reallocate resources within the state within the overall mission guidelines, appoint state technical consultant, give overall guidance and direction, nominate additional members invites, and monitor, review and evaluate implementation of the mission.

#### **PYKKA CELL:-**

Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan Cell at State level is functioning in the Directorate of sports and Youth Services, Nayapally, Bhubaneswar being the Director Sports and Youth Services as the **Mission Director**. He is being assisted by the other following staff for the present. The State Cell will function under the directives of the State Level Executive Committee constituted for the purpose.

1. Assistant Director Sports (in the rank of Class II State Sports Service)
2. Section Officer
3. Senior Assistant

The District Level PYKKA Cell is functioning in the respective District Offices being the District Sports Officer as the Nodal Officer and the Collector Concern as the chief Executive.

The District Cell will function under the directives of the District Level Executive Committee constituted for the purpose.

#### **State Technical Consultant :**

The State Technical Consultant has been engaged w.e.f. 6<sup>th</sup> February 2010. He has entrusted with the duty of preparing Training Schedule for Kridashree Training Programme, Providing inputs, for preparation of Competition details etc. identification of Sports disciplines at Block & District level, providing Technical Assistance for conduct of PYKKA Competitions, assisting in the preparation of DPR etc.

#### **Kridashree and Scope of Activities:-**

Kridashree in each PLIA shall be engaged by the concerned implementing Agency from among P.E.Ts., State and National Player, Ex-Servicemen, Veteran Sports Persons, Young Sports Persons with minimum qualification of 10+2/graduate. Due selection procedure shall be followed by the concerned district.

#### **Duties of Kridashree**

1. Impart training to the players and accompany with them to various competitions as and when required.
2. Supervise and up-keep the centre and Maintain and upgrade the Playfield
3. Motivate and encourage the players to join the centre
4. To remain in-charge of Stock and Store including Sports equipments
5. To liaison with concern Block and District Level PYKKA Cell officials

## **Training to Kridashree:-**

Selected Coaches of different disciplines working under Directorate of Sports and Youth Services will be under gone training at LNUPE Gwalior as Master Trainee in order to impart training to the Kridashrees.

## **Operational Aspects**

### **1. Sports Infrastructures: -**

Sports infrastructures so created under the Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abjhiyan scheme at Block Level and Panchayat Level will be put to use both for students and non students along with general public for practice of different games and Physical fitness. Kridashrees of these centres will act as nodal functionaries and will look after proper maintenance of the infrastructure.

### **2. Sports Equipments:-**

Funds sanctioned / available under the unit Acquisition grant will be fully spent for procurement of sports equipments as per local need according to identification of sports disciplines for the particular PLIA. Due procedure and transparency shall be maintained / followed in procuring quality sports materials. Related records /Register shall be maintained for audit and inspection.

### **3. Competitions and Sports disciplines :-**

20 sports disciplines have been included under the scheme. Districts are to identify minimum five sports disciplines for each PLIA from among the disciplines like Athletics, Kabadi, Kho-kho, Football, Volleyball, Archery, Hockey, Basketball, Wrestling, Weightlifting, Handball, Gymnastics and Swimming.

At the State level competitions the sports disciplines like Athletics, Volleyball, Basketball, Football, Archery, Kabaddi, Weightlifting, Wrestling, Hockey and Kho-Kho will be taken up.

Calendar for competitions will be determined and decided keeping in view to the National calendar of Sports Authority of India. Usually the Block level competitions are organized during the month of September, District level competitions during the month of October and State level Competitions during the month of November.

In the above 10 year prospective plan 100 % of the Blocks and Gram Panchayats covering 30 districts, 314 Block & 6236 Gram Panchayats will be covered by end of **2017-18**

**STRATEGY:-**

Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) Scheme aims at Sports for all. Therefore it is targeted that Odisha State will achieve optimum benefit out of it right from grass root level so that sports talents in different age group will come up for grooming at the identified PYKKA centers. Focus shall be given and strategy shall be on the followings:-

1. Mobilization of additional resources from different Schemes / programmers of the state Government such as NREGS, LAD fund, B.R.G.F, R.L.T.A.P., S.G.R.Y., S.C.A.,I.T.D.A., W.O.D.C.,R.S.V.Y. etc, to augment funds to the PYKKA centers for Providing better facilities for the sports infrastructures, procurement of adequate sports materials etc,
2. Other similar organizations / functionaries including Odisha based Leading Public Sector Undertakings, Business Houses, etc, working for promotion of sports and games in the state shall be approached to keep linkage with the mission Directorate Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) cell to work in furtherance for successful implementation of the scheme.
3. Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) Cell in the State will be widened with good number of manpower support and mobility facilities etc, to make the cell highly approachable to every nook and corners of the State proper supervision.
4. Constant monitoring and administrative supervision shall be made on the following important works :-
  - a. Timely submission of project proposal, Utilisation Certificates and other related documents including report and return to Government of India in time.
  - b. Regular supervision and monitoring on the progress of work relating to development of Sports Infrastructures, procurement of sports materials and assessment of the work of Kridashree etc, .
5. Competitions under the Scheme shall be conducted in a well planned manner. The popular sports disciplines at the area/locality will be covered. Proper attention will be given while conducting Block and District Level Sports Competitions so that players of each PYKKA centers are given scope to participate in the respective level of competitions.
6. For smooth and effective organization of State level competitions in case of non availability infrastructural facilities and other allied support such competition will be organized in group wise keeping in view the Schedule of the National Sports Calendar. Other sports programmes /Schemes of the State Government,

Government of India as well as Sports Authority of India will be closely monitored for identification of sports talents to facilitate them for the PYKKA Scheme.

7. Strong Motivation/ Drive will be initiated to involve the individuals, general public, Government organizations, Public Sector Undertakings, Business Houses etc, to join the main stream of the Scheme.
8. Various steps will be taken for highlighting the fact that the PYKKA Scheme has been sponsored by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India along with other awareness programmes at the time of holding function/ programme / events etc.

Panchayat Yuba Krida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) Scheme at large will undertake mission campaign for sports promotion in the State. Periodic conduct of work shop, Seminar, Symposium etc, will boost its effective functioning and will remove bottle necks/impediments etc, if any and will also facilitate the mission Directorate for preparation of the Action Plan accordingly.

All the 30 Districts, 314 Blocks, and 6236 Gram Panchayats of Odisha will be strongly benefitted out of this PYKKA Scheme. It will give a new fillip to the sports fraternity of all ages in the State.

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
