Long Advertisement

A Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) is being set up at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar. The KISCE will be equipped with high quality sports science equipment and manpower for providing best in-class training to the athletes of selected sports disciplines. Applications are invited from eligible applicants for the following posts, purely contractual in nature. Job description, qualifications and terms and conditions are mentioned under each post.

Post- Head of Sports & Exercise Science (No. of posts-1) (Consolidated remuneration of INR 2,00,000 per month)

Job description: The selected candidate will be responsible for the following:

1. To create, implement and manage a long-term sports science program (strength and conditioning) top-down and bottom-up for the Khelo India State Centre of Excellence in line with international standards,
2. Lead the Khelo India State Centre of Excellence sports science program and ensure that it is progressively implemented over all age groups (male/female) in close coordination with other High-Performance Centers, Sports Hostels and Academies in the State of Odisha,
3. Develop strength and conditioning modules for all focus sports disciplines in Odisha,
4. Create and implement a monitoring framework for the athletes receiving training at the Centre,
5. Mentor coaches in the State for imparting basic sports science training at various locations,
6. Produce individual and team phase reports including readiness, recovery, training and conditioning data. Provide high level of interpretation, recommendation and feedback to coaches and physios,
7. Optimize the utilization of Sports Science Staff at the Centre.

Qualifications:

1. The candidate must have Graduation (or equivalent qualification) in Sport Science or Strength & Conditioning/ Sports Medicine/ Physiotherapy.
2. The candidate must have experience as Head of Sports Science/ Performance Coach at youth, adolescent and senior level preferable across multiple sports disciplines.
3. The candidate must have professional experience of more than 20 years in the field of sports.
4. The candidate must be able to demonstrate ability to collect, interpret, and deliver training monitoring data (GPS, Heart rate, RPE, Wellness, etc.).

5. Experience in designing and implementing strength and conditioning or end stage return to play programs is desirable.
6. The candidate must have experience working in collaboration with coaches and other support staff for multiple sports disciplines.
7. English language proficiency (both written and spoken) is required.
8. Past experience and exposure to high performance sports will be given additional weightage.
9. Considering that this is a specialised field with a limited pool of experienced individuals, there is no age limit for the suitable candidate.

Post- Sports Medicine Doctor (No. of posts-1) (Consolidated remuneration of INR 1,50,000 per month)

Job description: The selected candidate will be responsible for the following:

1. Provide comprehensive diagnoses and treatment of sports or activity related injury,
2. Use manual techniques to prevent and treat muscular and skeletal conditions,
3. Provide athletes with education and counseling related to their injury,
4. Implement mental strategies that enable athletes to cope with and overcome setbacks or injuries,
5. Provide nutritional guidance to assist with the rehabilitation process,
6. Order and interpret results of diagnostic imaging procedures,
7. Record all medical care information and maintain medical records,
8. Evaluate athletes prior to sports participation to determine predisposition to injury,
9. Coordinate sports care activities with other medical experts,
10. Inform and counsel coaches and trainers on the medical condition of athletes,
11. Supervise the entire rehabilitation process,
12. Develop and implement procedures for dealing with emergency injury situations,
13. Conduct research into prevention and treatment of injuries or medical conditions,
14. Develop and prescribe exercise programs to condition rehabilitated athletes,
15. Tailor strategies that assist athletes in overcoming difficulties, improving performance and preparing for competition.

Qualifications:

1. The candidate must have MD (PMR/ Sports Medicine) qualification.
2. The candidate must have thorough understanding of sports culture and the ability to display sound judgment.
3. Experience in designing and implementing strength and conditioning or end stage return to play programs is desirable.
4. The candidate must have experience working in collaboration with coaches and other support staff.
5. English language proficiency (both written and spoken) is required.

Terms and conditions:

1. The engaged officer will be subject to and will abide by the conduct rules applicable to government servants of Odisha.
2. The appointee will furnish an undertaking at the time of joining in regard to the truth and correctness of information published by him/ her.

3. Either the appointee or DSYS can terminate the contract by mutual agreement after given 1-month notice period.
4. The selected candidate has to sign a contract with Sports & Youth Services Department and must be available for deployment at the KISCE, Odisha located at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar within 1 month of signing the contract.
5. The contract will be signed for 1 year, with the possibility of extending the contract on an annual basis, based on agreed upon revision in terms of the contract.

How to apply:

Interested candidates fulfilling the above criteria may apply with the following documents:

- i. Detailed biodata.
- ii. Self-attested copies of educational qualification (matriculations and onwards), proof of work experience and a proof of domicile.
- iii. 2 passport size photographs
- iv. An undertaking that there is no criminal prosecution contemplated or pending against the individual
